SIAM's mission

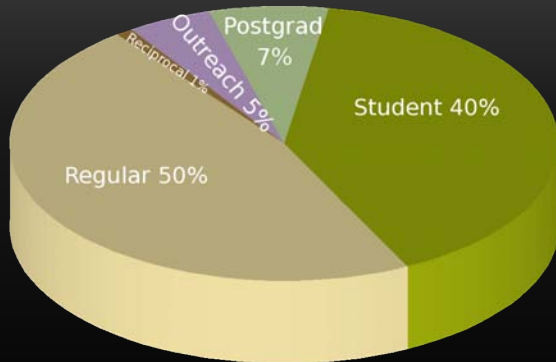
- Advance research and applications of mathematics and computational science
- Foster communication among mathematicians, engineers, and scientists
- Build community in applied mathematics and computational science
- Support the next generation studying and working in these areas

Major mechanisms

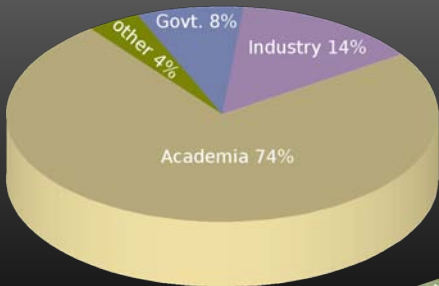
- **Publication** of journals and books
- **Organization of conferences**
- **Prize program** to recognize excellence
- **Student activities:** student chapters, SIURO, MCM, M³ Challenge, prizes, career info, . . .
- **Activity groups**
- **Advocacy and outreach** to government, industry, and the public

The SIAM Membership

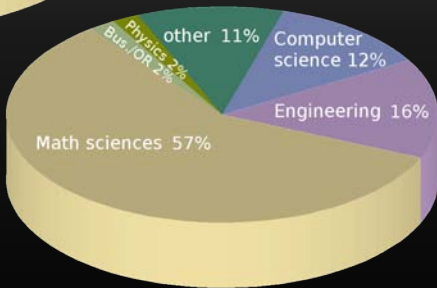
13,162 members at the end of 2009

Employer type



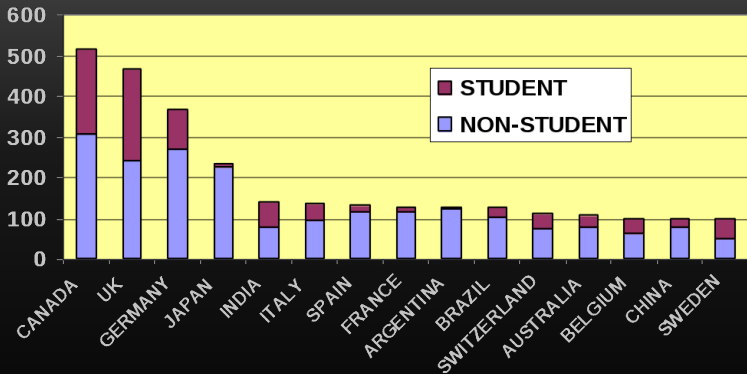

SIAM foreign membership by country

Members come from 93 countries (up 3).



SIAGs, sections, reciprocity, student chapters

- 17 SIAGS (up 1) with membership ranging from 85 to over 2,000; new: Algebraic Geometry; proposed: Uncertainty Quantification
- 8 regional sections, four in U.S. and four abroad
- reciprocity with 9 foreign societies (up 2: Israel, Scotland) and AWM (new!)
- 80 student chapters (up 13), 10 abroad

SIAM Publications

- 14 journals (new: Financial Mathematics)
- 3,550 submissions in 2009, a record, probably will be exceeded in 2010
- Time from acceptance to publication 2.8 months, cut in half since 2007
- Backlogs down
- CrossCheck now used to detect plagiarized submissions
- E-books on the way
- About 15 new book titles in 2009
- SIAM taking a lead in maintaining publishing integrity

SIAM Conferences

- 10 SIAM conferences held in 2009, and 10 planned for 2010
- 2 conferences held jointly with societies outside US
- Roughly 25% of participation by students
- Web page for proposing a conference in conjunction with SIAM
- ICIAM replaces SIAM meeting in 2011: Vancouver 7/18-22

Prize program

- SIAM awards 38 prizes, ranging from annual to every four years.
- 13 awarded by SIAGs (up 3, and growing)
- 4 student prizes
- 8 given jointly with other organizations

In 2010, SIAM Fellows were selected from nominations for the first time.

- 34 fellows were named.
- Nominations not selected remain active for 2 years.
- Nonacademic, non-US, and female members were underrepresented in the nominations.
- Next nomination deadline: November 1, 2010.

Governance

- **Officers:** Pres., Past Pres., VP at Large, VP for Publications/Programs/Education/Industry/Science Policy, Secretary, Treasurer
- **2010–11 VP at Large:** Nick Higham
2011–12 President: Nick Trefethen
- **SIAM Council:** formulates and monitors scientific activities, 14 + 9 ex officio
- **Board of Trustees:** responsible for the management of SIAM, 11 + 2 ex officio
- **Committees:** Nominating, Committees and Appointments, Sections, Diversity, Education, Major Awards, Membership, Program, Publications, Science Policy, . . .
- **SIAM Staff:** about 70 people under the Executive Director
