## SIAM Journals

## SIAM Journals

- Efforts to reduce time to publication
- Under 3 months, acceptance to publication (median time).
- Discussions on reducing review times
- Discussion on supplemental materials -where SIAM journals should position themselves for the future?


## SIAM Books

- SIAM publishes 20-25 books per year
- Newly launched e-book platform for institutional subscribers


## SIAM Conferences

- Active conference program with about 12 conferences per year
- SIAG (activity group) conferences, plus a few independent conferences
- About 4,000 attendees to SIAM conferences in a typical year


## Student Travel Awards

- SIAM has support for student travel from various sources:
- NSF grant (38 students and 38 postdoc/early career)
- SIAM Student Travel Fund (36 students)
- Money donated by authors (book royalties) and members.
- Decision by Board to add $\$ 100 \mathrm{~K} / \mathrm{yr}$ from SIAM funds for student travel, beginning 2012
