North Carolina school wins top dollar in 10th Annual M³ Challenge

Five high school students from North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics (NCSSM) <u>earned top</u> <u>honors</u> for their cost-benefit analysis of obtaining a college degree in the 10th annual <u>Moody's Mega</u> <u>Math (M³) Challenge</u>, just as they prepare to embark on their own college careers. The winning team, one of two finalist teams from the same high school in Durham, N.C., prevailed over more than 5,000 students comprising 1,128 teams in the national math modeling competition organized by SIAM, which this year required participants to answer the question, "Is college worth it?" After successfully presenting and defending their solutions before a panel of PhD-level professional mathematicians at The Moody's Foundation headquarters, the Champion NCSSM team took home \$20,000 in scholarship funds. Another NCCSM team claimed the \$15,000 second place prize.
